Alise, thanks for another great class!

On February 5th, we will be inking the 'Seagull', taught by Cheri Bergquist. There is no prep work for this class and all you need are Micron Pens (#.005, .01, .08) and a small round or flat brush to apply the tints. There is a \$2 supply fee to cover the cost of the paper that will be prepared with the pattern already applied and the water-colors. (Watercolor washes can be added after the piece is completed if you choose to do so.) This is a fun and EASY class and no need to haul a ton of supplies. Ladies, we only have a few seats left, so please contact me ASAP by phone or email.

In March, we will be painting 'Abstract Sunflowers'. This a lovely watercolor taught by Paula Tormey. Paula comments that, "The final step after you have painted what you think is finished, is reviewing your final piece and then actually finishing it!" Paula will be providing the watercolor paints and Designer Gouache. This is a great opportunity to continue developing your watercolor skills.


