





We are able to get the boxes for \$2 each so I loaded up!

I have included pictures of boxes from Barbara Fries, Betty Wiersma, Doris Tanis, Lynn Rankin and our new member Roxanne Puchalski. Every new box I brought to our class/Christmas party on December 4th was taken by members to paint. Wow!

I have had questions about the number of children in each age group in foster care. There are two teen boys group homes and one teen girls group home in Flagler County. There are 5-6 teens per group. Here is an estimated breakdown from Guardian ad litem:
