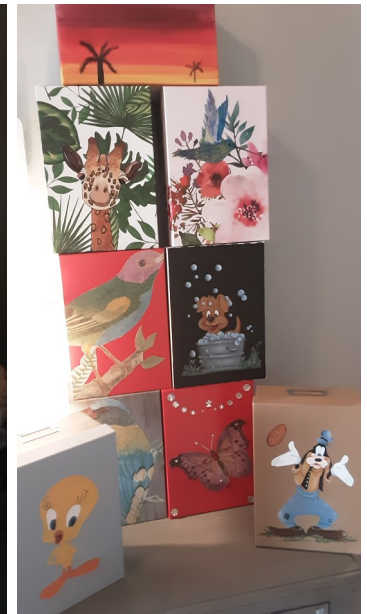


Kids R First Update
