#### Letter fom the 1st Vice President

Hi Ladies -

Thanks Cheri for another great class. I've seen some of the butterflies that the ladies have colorized and they are just beautiful. I hope they will share them with you the next time you are in Palm Coast. Diane's mini-class will also be very helpful in prepping your surfaces for the "Florida Swamp' project. Thanks, Diane.

On July 6th, Cindy Makowski will be teaching us to paint a 'Florida Swamp'. This is an acrylic project that focuses on glazing colors to create sun rays and fog. These techniques will be reusable in many of your painting projects and is a <u>class that no one should miss</u>. Please note there is prep work that needs to be done before this class, so sign up early!

In our July's mini-class, Lana will demonstrate how to set up your painting surface.

Our luncheon menu for July is a large antipasto salad with bread & rolls, as well as drinks served by Noreen. As always, our luncheon donation is \$5.

The August 3<sup>rd</sup> Workshop will feature a 'Magnolia' taught by Lisa Fox. This project will continue building on your new watercolor skills. It is a lovely companion piece to the 'Sunflower' Lisa taught earlier in the year. Lisa will be supplying the watercolor paper and paints. She has requested that you bring #6, #8 and liner brushes, as well as a flat brush to fill in the dark background. You will also need paper towels and a water bucket. Everything will be prepped and ready for you to paint. I know you love "no prep" classes!

The September 7<sup>th</sup> Workshop, features an original design of a 'Koi Pond' taught by Cindy Makowski. This project uses acrylics for the under painting and oils to float over the under painting for shading and highlighting. This same technique can be used on other paintings you have already done to really bring them to life. It's a wonderful technique to have in your painting toolbox. Cindy will be supplying the paints for this project.

Sign-ups for the July, August and September Workshops are now being taken. All prep instructions for these Workshops will be available at the July meeting or before.

Don't forget, you can always join the Wednesday painting sessions at the Palm Coast Community Center from 9am to 11:30am. They are free and open to all. No advance preparation or reservations are needed – just come!

## Palm Coast Decorative Artists Club Meeting Minutes—June 1, 2024
