Hi Ladies -

I hope everyone enjoyed painting 'Three Tomatoes' and learned some new watercolor techniques. Thanks Paula for a very informative class. And also thanks to Kathy Lamb for a very informative mini-workshop. Make sure you all continue practicing those comma strokes!

On June 1st, Cheri Bergquist will be teaching a beautiful 'Zentangle Butterfly' that can be left plain or have coloring added. Cheri will prepare your design on Bristol paper for a \$3 supply fee. If you choose, you can do this bit of prep yourself with the pattern design she has supplied.

This month the mini-class will focus on teaching us to use tape to cover birds, etc. (I know this will be useful to know for the July Workshop.) Diane Foreman will be teaching this lesson.

Lana Raymond will be serving the June lunch featuring assorted sandwiches with all the trimmings for only \$5.

On July 6th, Cindy Makowski will be back teaching us to paint a 'Florida Swamp'. This is an acrylic project that will focus on glazing colors to create sun rays and fog. These techniques will be reusable in many of your painting projects and is a class that no one should miss. Please note there is prep work that needs to be done before this class, so sign up early!

The August 3rd Workshop will feature a 'Magnolia' taught by Lisa Fox. This project will continue building on your new watercolor skills. Also, it is a lovely companion piece to the 'Sunflower' Lisa taught earlier in the year. Lisa will be supplying the watercolor paper and paints. She has requested that you bring #6, #8 and liner brushes, as well as a flat brush to fill in the dark background. You will also need paper towels and a water bucket. Everything will be prepped and ready for you to paint. I know you love "no prep" classes!

Sign-ups for the June, July and August Workshops are now being taken. All prep instructions for these Workshops will be available at the June meeting or before.

Don't forget, you can always join the Wednesday painting sessions at the Palm Coast Community Center from 9am to 11:30am. They are free and open to all. No advance preparation or reservations are needed – just come!
